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#### Introduction

This document details the integration common issues or 'gotchas' to look out for between Dynamics NAV and Document Management 4.5 (DM).

In general, if the pre-requisites have been satisfied and instructions followed, you should get few problems, however there of course head scratchers that can happen.

This document will grow over time based on the experiences of Professional Services and support so the more it is added too, the more benefit it will be.

# **DbLogin**

- ► Ensure the mandatory users are created
- ▶ Ensure the DbLogin users are given the access to the software they need

### **DbArchive**

- ► Ensure all the #USES paths are set in the def files
- ► Ensure the V1\_SETTINGS.def is configured to reflect the environment
- ► Ensure access to the Dynamics companies are added to the DBA\_FILTER\_MAP table using the connector

# **DbCapture**

- ► Ensure DbLogin users are assigned the queue states based on the companies they require access too
- ► Ensure the Companies.xml file is configured to reflect the Companies required by the integration

## **Web-services**

As per the server side instructions, ensure sure they're activated
